

PIC Release 5.2 Summary

| Item | SubModule | Issue | Description |
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| 1 | HA | Functionality to delete incorrect occupancy report | New option for PIC Users to delete the occupancy report (Form-51234) which has not been approved by the Field office. |
| 2 | DEMO DISPO | Ability to add developments with zero units to Demo Dispo | PIC System will now let the user add a development with zero units to Demo/ Dispo. This will permit users to do land dispositions under Section 18 of the US Housing Act of 1937. |
| 3 | HA | No Business Function Defined Error in HA Sub module. | Corrects a problem where a user id (TARC HA) has access to both TARC and FO, they would receive a "No business function defined" error in the HA submodule. |
| 4 | HA | Ability to change Participant type | When a HUD User creates a PHA in the Housing Authority submodule, the user selects a "Participant Type" - either "SHA" (State Housing Authority) or "PHA" (Public Housing Authority). Changes default to "Public Housing Authority. |
| 5 | HA | Ha List Page will now display Inactive HAs | HA list page has been changed so it properly displays inactive HAs when the option is selected. |
| 6 | DEV | Allow user to change 'unit tenant type' for a single unit | PIC will now allow User To Change 'Unit Tenant Type' For A Single Unit in the Development submodule, Unit tab. |
| 7 | SEC ADMIN | Correct error when deleting local roles | Corrects problem for Super User getting '9605' error when deleting local security roles. |
| 8 | Demo-Dispo & Housing Authority | D-D submodule not extracting the proper data from HA Submodule | Corrects problem with Demo-Dispo application that does not properly display Exec. Director or Acting Exec. Director in the pull-down box for entering the Exec. Director's name in the D-D application. If the Exec. Director's name is added to the HA module contacts later, it can be added to the application later. |
| 9 | 50058 | Ig audit issues | The Total Tenant Payment, TTP (field 9j) was not trapping obviously erroneous values such as 99999. PIC now requires a value of \$0 - \$2250 per the TRG. |
| 10 | 50058 | RCR Report at development level displays only Dwelling Units for Pub Housing | Corrects 'Available Units' and 'Occupied Units' in the RCR Report for Public Housing at the Development Level. Available units include only Dwelling units and the occupied units are now being taken from the right column in the physical development table. (By making this change there will be a discrepancy with the Vacancy/Occupancy Report in the Total Number of Available units.) |
| 11 | 50058 | Transaction Report does not show fields 7i and 8y for some tenants | Corrects a problem with the MTCS Transaction Report that did not show "Total Annual Income" and/or "Adj. Annual Income" (fields 7i and 8y) for some tenants. This has been corrected. |
| 12 | 50058 | Submission throws exception when duplicate "Other Special Program Indicator" types are sent | Corrects a problem where the user sends in two or more of the same "Other Special Program Indicator" types. Now the system will create an error report if the user sends two or more of the same program types. In addition, case sensitivity has been removed from 'Other Special Program' codes.. |
| 13 | 50058 | Identify and Fix Form 50058-Viewer | The page display in the Viewer has been updated so it will properly display new special program codes. |
| 14 | 50058 | Error Processing Action 8 as Correction | Corrects a problem users have had when submitting a correction for action type 8. (Users were getting 'FATAL: 4084 - Correction Date is an invalid date' even |

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| | | | though a valid correction date was sent in). |
| 15 | 50058 | Zip codes are not being displayed properly for Public Housing Units in Viewer | In Viewer "Unit to be occupied" page is now properly displaying the complete zip code for Public Housing Units. (Formerly, only the first 5 digits of the 9-digit zip code were returned for Public Housing. Since the formatting is based on a 9 digit value the system was showing incorrect zip codes when 5 digits are returned e.g. '03060' will show as '030603060'. (Note: The problem was in the display, not in the database that stores the data). |
| 16 | 50058 | Copying field 2q thru 2u from Current to History | Corrects a problem where HAs have reported cases where successful submissions (no errors in error report) are not appearing in the database. It has been determined there was a defect in the code so that if one of the 'PHA Use' columns contained an apostrophe, PIC was unable to copy this value from current to history because the apostrophe caused an invalid SQL statement to be formed. The 2q-2u apostrophe problem has been corrected. |
| 17 | 50058 | Fatal Error 4222, Eligible Non-Citizens Being Ignored | HAs have reported submission errors where there were eligible non-citizens in the family but fatal error 4222 was returned. This problem was due to a defect in the submission logic that said if the head of household is an ineligible non-citizen, ignore any eligible non-citizens. This has been corrected. |
| 18 | 50058 | New Admissions for Certificate Program Type not getting updated in the database | Some certificate new admissions were not being updated. This has been corrected. |
| 19 | 50058 | Submission Issues Regarding Action Type 13 (Housing Quality Inspection, HQS) | Field 5h (date unit last passed inspection) will no longer be updated for action type 13 (HQS). When action type 13 is sent, the current record will be moved into history and field 5i (but not 5h) will be updated in the current record. (This will permit proper assessment of SEMAP Indicator 11 after one year of data has been collected.) |
| 20 | 50058 | Invalid EOP Accepted | The system was accepting an EOP for a public housing tenant with the incorrect development, building, and unit number if the invalid unit sent was vacant. This was resulting in orphaned units. The basic record validation code has been fixed so if an HA sends an EOP with incorrect unit information an error will be displayed. |
| 21 | 50058 | Download button not working in the Late HQS Report | The download to Excel button was not working for the Late HQS report. It does now.. |
| 22 | 50058 | Download button not working in Rent Calc. Report | The download to Excel button was not working for the Rent Calculation Report. It does now. |
| 23 | 50058 | Correct calculation for Imputed Asset Income (field 6i) | Corrects a problem with the calculation for field 6i (Imputed Asset Income. (The data type precision of the variables used in the calculation was corrected.) |
| 24 | 50058 | Convert PHA Codes and Development Code from Lowercase to Uppercase | Corrects a problem with submitting 50058 forms due to Fatal Error 4006 due to a case sensitivity issue where the PHA code in the database and the PHA code submitted are case mismatched. Implemented a data |

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| | | | fix to resolve previous instances of this issue and the code has been modified to ignore case when validating PHA codes. Also, PHA codes are now converted to uppercase before being written into the database |
| 25-1 thru 25-6 | 50058 | Participant Codes Do Not Match Between The Household And Household Member Table | Some HAs have reported not being able to view tenant records in the submission viewer. This problem has been identified as a result of the participant codes not matching for these tenants between the household and household member table. The vast majority of these cases have been identified as a result of action type 5 being sent where action type 4 has not yet been sent in. Currently, when action type 5 is sent, the submission process checks to see if the participant code sent matches the move-in participant code. If the codes match OR there was no move-in PHA (null) then the household table but not the member table is updated. Otherwise the historical household and historical member tables are updated for that HA. The code needs to be modified such that (for action type 5) it checks the participant code in the current household table for a match. If the two are equal then it will perform the same business logic. If the participant code sent does not match the participant code in the current household table then the code should update the information and update date for all section 8 tables in the historical database for the participant code sent in. If there are no historical records for the participant then the action type 5 should be rejected. |
| 26 | HA | Password Field length should be 14 characters. | Password field will now permit only 8-14 alphanumeric characters (A-Z, a-z, 0-9), hyphen (-) and underscore (_) characters. It will not accept malicious code or characters (!, * < > etc.). |
| 27 | Development | RASS Report is pulling door numbers for 'SF', 'SD', & 'RW' structures | RASS Extract revised to omit door numbers in the addresses for Single Family(SF), Semi-Detached (SD), & Row/Townhouse (RW) structure types. It will now only include door numbers in the addresses for Elevator (ES) and .Walkup (WU) structure types. |
